

You can help Tiffin Right to Life by volunteering for one or more of these committees

Prayer Committee – Members agree to: 1) Pray the rosary at home for preborn babies and/or, 2) Meet with a small group and assist a leader in praying the rosary at a local nursing home and/or, 3) Participate in praying the rosary led by a leader either at St. Mary Church at 8:00 AM on Wednesdays (before Mass), or at St. Joseph Church after the 5:15 PM Mass on Wednesdays.

Fundraising Committee (Spring or Fall)– Members work with a leader and others on a specific fundraising event (e.g. annual geranium sale in May, or annual dinner event in the fall). This could involve assisting with subcommittees for advertising, decorating, baking, sales, set-up, clean-up, etc.

Heritage Parade Float Committee – Members work with a leader to encourage young people from Seneca County to decorate and accompany a pro-life float for Tiffin’s annual Heritage Festival Parade in September. Be a public witness for the sanctity of life at this parade.

Legislative Committee – Members assist a leader by monitoring websites and other news sources to learn about life issues at the State and Federal level, and share this information with the membership.

Local March for Life -- Members assist a leader to plan our January March for Life in Tiffin.

Mass Planning / Devotional Services Committee – Members assist in planning a specific Mass or other devotional service to bring about an awareness for the sanctity of life. Examples: Help to organize special prayers and a local March for Life each January, **or** help to organize the “Blessing for Babies and Children” during the spring and fall National “40 Days for Life” campaign, **or** assist in organizing a Mass and/or Prayers in March for families who have experienced loss from stillborn or miscarried babies, **or** help plan special prayer services in September for the National Day of Remembrance of Aborted Babies.

Membership Committee – Members help the committee leader each January with updating membership renewal information, (verifying committee choices, noting changes of address/phone/email and other comments by members.

Roe vs. Wade Committee – Members help collect signatures and donations for the annual full-page ad placed in The Advertiser-Tribune that publicly states opposition to the 1973 Supreme Court case that legalized abortion on demand. Collections are done at local churches before/after church services during one weekend in early January.

Seneca County Fair Committee – Members agree to work a specific shift to staff a pro-life booth at the Seneca County Fair and hand out literature about life issues. (New Riegel and Bascom/Fostoria RTL join in this project.)

Speaker Committee – Members agree to present pro-life talks to Calvert Catholic Schools, CCD students, and other churches or community organizations who request a speaker about life issues.

Inactive Committee –Members who pay annual dues but are not able to attend quarterly meetings or serve on specific committees are asked to provide prayer support from their homes for preborn babies and for a respect for all human life from the womb to the tomb.
