## Tiffin Right to Life marches for the unborn

About 200 people gathered in downtown Tiffin Sunday afternoon to join the Tiffin Right to Life's annual Ecumenical March for Life.

The yearly march commemorates the Roe vs. Wade Supreme Court decision in 1973 that legalized abortion.

The group, made up of students, Knights of

Columbus members and other local residents, walked together through parts of downtown Tiffin and assembled at various sites to hear remarks.

Fr. Joseph Szybka, Pastor, first spoke at St. Joseph Church, along with Maggie Viertbeck from Maumee whose daughter, Annie, is featured on the billboard at the intersection of US 224 and SR 18.

After processing to the Seneca County Justice Center, Rev. Stephanie Little of Little Faith Ministries in Tiffin spoke to the crowd.

The procession continued on to St. Mary Church, where Fr. Rader, Pastor, delivered a short speech and a blessing.

“Right to Life supports all life, from conception to natural death,” a release from the group states.
